







Supplementary Regulations UEM CCE Cup 11.07.2010 EMN 36/3

1. General

The competition is held in accordance with the UEM Sporting Code and UEM Regulations for the European Cross Country Enduro Cup and this Supplementary Regulations that has been approved by the UEM.

The competition will take place **Sunday 11th of July at Prästtomta Military Training Ground** 25 km NNO of Linköping. N 58° 38.245′, E 15° 25.778′

3. Road Guidance

The road to the race ground are marked with arrows from E 4 Linköping exit (Berg – Vreta Kloster), from road 34 Borensberg exit (Tjällmo) and from road 211 at Tjällmo.

4. Entries

The organizer should have a complete UEM entry form from each rider no later then 11th of June. The entry form should be sent to the organizer by post, fax or e-mail:

A provisional entry list will be published on the Web site of the event continuously, www.stangebroslaget.com.

5. Entry fee

The entry fee is 50 €for all classes and should be paid to SWEDBANK before the entry will be accepted. SWEDBANK's BIC is SWEDSESS and the IBAN number is SE78 8000 0848 0600 3097 8076.

6. Competitors

All the riders must hold a valid FIM/UEM or National Enduro/Motocross license and have a starting permit from his/her National Federation (FMNR). Further on the rider has to have an insurance confirmed by his/her FMN and be a minimum age of 16 years.

RACE CONDITIONS

8. Course

The Competition is a Cross Country Enduro on a marked circuit, lap distance 22 km.

Class 1, 2 and 3 rides 5 laps on the 22 km circuit.

Class 4 rides 1,5 hrs on a shorten circuit, ca 9 km.

The average speed is ca 45 km/hrs.

The organizer reserves the right to changing the number of laps and the length of the circuit depending on the actual conditions on the day of the competition. The intention are that class 1-3 will ride for about 2 hrs 50 min and class 4 will ride for 1 hrs 30 min.

Marshals will monitor the race around the course.

9. Administrative Control

Race Office will be open on Friday the 9th from 07.00 to 21.00 hrs and on Saturday the 10th from 07.00 to 18.00 hrs. At the administrative inspection the rider must submit his/her FIM, UEM or National Rider's Licence, confirmation of entry fee payment, filled entry form and starting permission from FMNs confirming insurance.

10. Technical Inspection

The Technical Inspection is open on **Saturday the 10th** from **17.00 to 21.00 hrs**. All vehicles will be checked when it comes to sound and the vehicles must be within 94 db according to the UEM Enduro Rules. **It allowed using off road (MX) tyres**.

11. Riders meeting

A Riders Meeting will be held for international competitors outside the Race Office on Saturday the 10th of July at 16.30 hrs.

12. Environment

It's mandatory to use an Environmental Mat in the Pit area. Team not equipped with an Environmental Mat will not be allowed to enter the Pit area. Rider who are assisted or have the bike refilled outside the Pit area will be disqualified.

About 300 m from the Pit area there is a clearly marked Ecological area there competitors could leave hazardous material such as oil, tyres, battery etc.

13. Prizes and Prize Giving Ceremony

Prizes are awarded to the 3 best riders overall and to the 3 best riders in each class. The Prize Giving ceremony will take place outside the Race Office 60 min after that the last rider has finished the race.

14. Time limit

Each rider in class 1 to 3 have to finish the race no later then 60 min after that the overall winner has passed the finish line in order to complete the race. Estimated time for one lap is 32 min. Rider in class 4 (Quad) has to cross the finish line no later then 20 min after the winner has passed the finish line in order to complete the race, estimated time for one lap is 12 min.

15. Results

The official results will be put up at the Race Office as soon as the time for protest is ended, 30 min after the arrival of the last rider in each class. The result will also be published on www.stangebroslaget.com.

16. Start

The start procedure will be as follows. The Quad class will start for themselves and have there own race on a shortened circuit. The motorcycle classes will start in the following order all riders in Senior class start together 2 min later followed by all Juniors and after another 2 min all riders in the Veteran class. All starts will be conducted with stopped engine.

Each class will be lined up with 50 riders per line and then another 50 rider behind etc. up to the maximum of 200 hundred riders per class. The riders will enter the starting area according to the present standing in the UEM CCE.

17. Equipment

Riders, their bikes and protection clothing should comply with UEM Regulations.
