## **MACEC CONGRESS**

The 7<sup>th</sup> Congress of MACEC, the regional UEM association that groups the motorcycling national Federations of Central Europe, was held on Saturday the 12th of February in Bratislava at the new Slovakiaring circuit.

After an introductory salute by the UEM, with the President Vincenzo Mazzi and the Vice-President Michal Sikora, and by the FIM, with the Vice-President Andrzej Witkowski, the delegates of the national Federations of Poland, Ukraine, Belarus, Moldova, Romania and Slovakia (missing those of Lithuania because of a concomitant engagement in Vilnius) discussed on several issues relating activities in their countries, approved 2010 sporting results and defined the 2011 calendar of Motocross, Enduro, Trial and Speedway.

The President Andrzej Grodzki was re-elected unanimously together with the Vice-Presidents Serhiy Lyatosinskyy, Peter Lazar and Gherorghe Voicolescu and the General Secretary Aleksandra Knyszewska.

Previously, the UEM President, together with the President of the Slovakian Federation Peter Smizik, had the chance to meet the President of the Slovakian Republic, Ivan Gasparovic, big fan of motorcycling sports, and with the General Director of the Ministry of Education, Science, Research and Sport, Pavol Swiec, with whom examined some development opportunities of motorcycling sport in Slovakia, in particular after the opening of the modern circuit of Slovakiaring.

Next MACEC Congress will be held in Chisinau (Moldova) in the February of 2012.
